

CODA 2020 PROGRAM DESIGN ELEMENTS CPD/CME

**THE ENTIRE PROGRAM HAS BEEN DESIGNED WITHIN A
FRAMEWORK OF PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT**

Professional bodies representing healthcare providers the world over recognise the importance of Continuing Professional Development (CPD), also sometimes known as Continuing Medical education (CME).

They also acknowledge and adopt a holistic approach to professional development, taking in a number of diverse domains.

The Coda2020 plenary program has been carefully constructed to include all of these domains in the learning objectives for each session.

On the program itself you can see which learning domains are identified in each session and the relevant learning objectives are stated.

CLINICAL EXPERTISE

Refers to acquiring both the Knowledge and Skills to be able to deliver high quality, safe and effective care.

SCHOLARSHIP & TEACHING

This includes the creation, translation, application and dissemination of medical knowledge.

PROFESSIONALISM & SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

Advocating for the vulnerable and addressing disparities. This includes health promotion, cultural competence and ethical principles.

LEADERSHIP & MANAGEMENT

Requires knowledge and skill to manage the workplace obligations, conflict resolution, KPI's, change and financial considerations. Additionally, recognising organisational structures, governance, requirements of supervision, QI, Safety and data collection.

COMMUNICATION

Developing the capability to communicate effectively with patients, families and colleagues in complex environments, teams and situations while understanding barriers, cultural and social contexts and being able to provide effective feedback.

TEAMWORK & COLLABORATION

The ability to both manage and participate in, inter-professional multi-disciplinary teams. This requires understanding the teams' function, member roles and the intricacies of debriefing.



A FULLY BALANCED ACADEMIC PROGRAM WITH ALL FOUR CODA COMMITMENTS PRESENTED IN ONE SESSION EACH DAY

Feedback from the SMACC and Coda medical communities has radically evolved the program design in both content and format. Delegate feedback for future programs has been broadly categorised into four threats to global health - we call these our commitments:

CODA CURE

Threats include sepsis, antimicrobial resistance, trauma and communicable disease.

CODA EDUCATE

Threats include Inequity within healthcare including inequity to knowledge and learning, medical misinformation, vaccine hesitancy and artificial intelligence.

CODA EARTH

Threats to humanity from climate change, water and food shortages, air pollution.

CODA ETHICS

Threats include inequity within healthcare including, gender, income, race and geography. Additionally, global population, genetic manipulation, AI and end of life care.

THE PRESENTATION FORMAT OF EACH DAY REFLECTS THE BROADER LEARNING OBJECTIVES AND EVOLVES TO DELIVER A TRULY IMMERSIVE EDUCATIONAL EXPERIENCE

Presenting the education in an engaging format underpins and highlights the learning objectives. We have carefully chosen different presentation styles / formats for each day that we believe will provide a truly immersive and lasting educational experience:

DAY 1 - UNFREEZING OUR THINKING

The 4 pillars of our CODA mission: Earth, Cure, Educate and Ethics provide the scaffolding for us to discuss the issues that loom large in our thinking. Day One is about unlocking our shared potential. We invite you to step in, leaving behind fixed ideas and easy solutions. We have curated a line-up of speakers, and challenged each of them to bring us new rich narratives, that directly address the issues we are most passionate about. We know these stories have the capacity to unfreeze and unlock change, inspiring us with new ideas, new language and new conversations.

DAY 2 - CO-CREATION / COLLABORATIVE SOLUTIONS

Day Two emphasises the power when we build together. We've unlocked ideas and possibilities and now we will begin to create together. The format and tempo shifts from a heavier reliance on individual storytelling to collaboration. We use panels, forums, interviews and conversations as a roadmap for new collaborations and unlikely partnerships. On Day Two you will see the catalytic quality that arises when people like us come together to create the future.

DAY 3 - COACHING FOR ACTION

Day Three is where we turn our stories into action. Today is your invitation, as part of the Coda family, to take personal responsibility for forging a new path. The tempo changes again as we begin to refine our actions and prepare our plans for transformation with a sense of urgency and hope. The speakers are narrating now as coaches with the delegates actively responding. Day Three is what it looks like before every social change takes place. This is the Coda Change. We have assembled the best of the best to present the program guaranteeing that attendees will take away clear learning objectives and be inspired to deliver the best care.

The broad principles driving speaker selections are:

EDUCATIONAL PRINCIPLES HAVE BEEN APPLIED FIRST

The evolving format and narrative structure of the three days and the Coda Pillars, means that we started at the end objective and worked back. We asked the question, “who is the Coda Community and which voices and stories and formats will help us come together in action?” We began with a framework of professional development curricula in mind and an agenda of intended learning outcomes focusing our choice of speakers to those with the skill and style to drive to this.

DIVERSITY AND INCLUSION

We needed to carry the fire from SMACC, listening to who has been missing in critical conversations and bringing different voices and faces into the spotlight. This crystallised in the idea of “big names that you may not have heard of yet”.

PEOPLE THAT “GET” CODA AND MAKE IT AUTHENTIC

The biggest positive lesson from SMACC programs is that we want speakers who become integral to the community. This is evident in people wanting to speak, not needing to be pursued and convinced; wanting to come and be part of the festivities and build ideas together.

THE VALUE FOR YOU, THE DELEGATES

While it is important to venture out and entice new voices with reputations from outside our community, this has been carefully balanced with our status as a not-for-profit charitable trust and the desire to return as much as possible back into the experiences of the Coda20 delegates, and the broader Coda healthcare community.
